



## **Global Professional Organizers Learn & Collaborate in Florida, USA**

**ORLANDO, Fla. - Sept. 15, 2019 - [PRLog](#)** -- The Institute for Challenging Disorganization® (ICD) is holding a 3-day conference at the Embassy Suites in Lake Buena Vista, Orlando September 19 -21, 2019. - Chronic Disorganization is defined as having a past history of disorganization, undermining of current quality of life due to disorganization, failed self-help efforts to change, and an expectation of future disorganization.
